GCSE Results Day – Advice for Students and Parents

We understand that GCSE results day may be a particularly anxious time for students in Year 11. Exeter College would like to reassure you that, no matter what results you receive, we are here to support you to find a course that's right for you and your ambitions.

The Exeter College GCSE advice line is open from 8.30am on Thursday 20th August to the end of the enrolment period on Thursday 3rd September. If you have any concerns or queries about your GCSE results, please call 01392 40055 to receive advice and guidance.

If you have **not** achieved the grades required for your next step, then the following is likely to apply:

Full Time Vocational Programme

- There may be a suitable course at a lower level. Attend your scheduled enrolment appointment to discuss your options.

A Levels

- If you have missed one or two required grades but have a grade 4 or above in English and Maths, then attend your scheduled enrolment appointment to discuss your options.
- If you have achieved mainly grade 3s or below, or grade 3s in English and Maths, then call the advice line for further support.

Apprenticeships

- If you have an employer to support your apprenticeship, contact the apprenticeship team on 01392 400800.
- If you do not have an employer to support your apprenticeship, then attend your scheduled enrolment appointment to discuss full time options at college. You can also contact the apprenticeship team on 01392 400800 to discuss current vacancies.

Enrolment

- All students who have a conditional offer to study with Exeter College will be informed, at the beginning of August, about their individual enrolment appointment.

- Enrolment is scheduled to take place from 1pm on 20th August through to Thursday 3rd September.
