Dear Parents/Guardians,

COVID19 – Year 10 Parent Update 02.07.2020

Having carefully considered how best to ensure that students go into the summer holidays feeling clear, prepared and reassured about the start of the next academic year, we have made the decision to focus teaching in the final week of term on **option subjects**.

With this in mind, each Year 10 student will be asked to attend school for one day in the week commencing 13th July. During that day, they will take part in three extended lessons, one for each of their three option subjects, eg. Geography, Computer Science, Dance. Student groups are invited into school as follows:

Registration will take place at 8.45am in their usual pod rooms. Students should use their current pod entrance and follow the same safety procedures while on the school site as they have so far this term.

As previously, students with vulnerabilities/medical conditions who need to be dropped off on site should arrive at school before 08.45am and we would request that the school is notified of this in advance.

If one of your child's options includes PE or Dance, we would ask that they attend school in their school sports kit to avoid having to change during the school day.

Can we please also remind you that students should bring enough water with them for the day as it will not be possible to use the water fountains on site. They will also need to have on their account, or bring with them, enough money if they wish to order lunch from the school canteen.

Attached to this letter is an individualised information sheet for your child, to summarise arrangements.
