Isca Academy Summer School 2020

We are delighted to invite your child to attend the Summer School. This will take place on either 18th or 19th August. Students will be able to attend on **one** of these days depending on which tutor group they are in. The idea of the day is to allow them time to have fun and make some new friends who will be in their tutor group when they start at Isca Academy in September.

Due to the current regulations we have to limit the group sizes to 15 students. The activities for the day will be run by UX2, a military inspired personal development provider, who we have worked with for a number of years. They provide engaging activities focusing on teamwork, leadership and communication skills, as well as boosting students' confidence and resilience. Academy staff will also be on hand throughout the day.

The activities will take place outside no matter what the weather, students will need to bring a sun hat and sun cream and a waterproof in case of rain. **All students must bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink** (no fizzy drinks please), they will be able to refill water bottles during the day.

The tutor group your child is in will decide on the allocated day, so we can ensure numbers meet the government guidelines and students get to meet members of their tutor group.

The day will start at 9.00am, students should arrive no more than 15 minutes before in comfortable clothing that they can easily move around in, they need to register with Isca staff at the front of the school. The day will end at 3.15pm. Please make sure your child is either collected from school or we are aware that they are able to make their own way home.

Please note students must remain at home if they or a member of their household has Covid-19 type symptoms on the day.
