General Information

- Scholars can only choose ONE enrichment week option e.g. Inspiration scholar.
- Activities require a £10 deposit and this is non-refundable.
- All activity choices have a total fee of £26 (remissions will be applied to those entitled)
- Details outlined for the activities are correct at the time of publication if there are any changes to itineraries, parents will be notified.
- All visit days will be within normal school hours and scholars will be back on school site by 3.15pm.

What you need to do

- Complete payment via SCOPay.
- Allocation is on a first come, first serve basis so make sure you get your first choice by completing SCOPay payment as soon as possible.

- Payments need to be made through Isca Academy's online payment system www.scopay.com
- Payments on SCOPAY will open on 7th June and we MUST receive all payments in full before Monday 3rd July.
- Unfortunately if full payment is not received by this date the place will be withdrawn.
- If your child receives free school meals they will be provided with a lunch grab-bag for every offsite activity day (the school kitchen will be open as usual for onsite activities).
- If your child does not receive a free school meal then please provide them with money to purchase food when at offsite activities (the school kitchen will be open as usual for onsite activities).

Behaviour information
